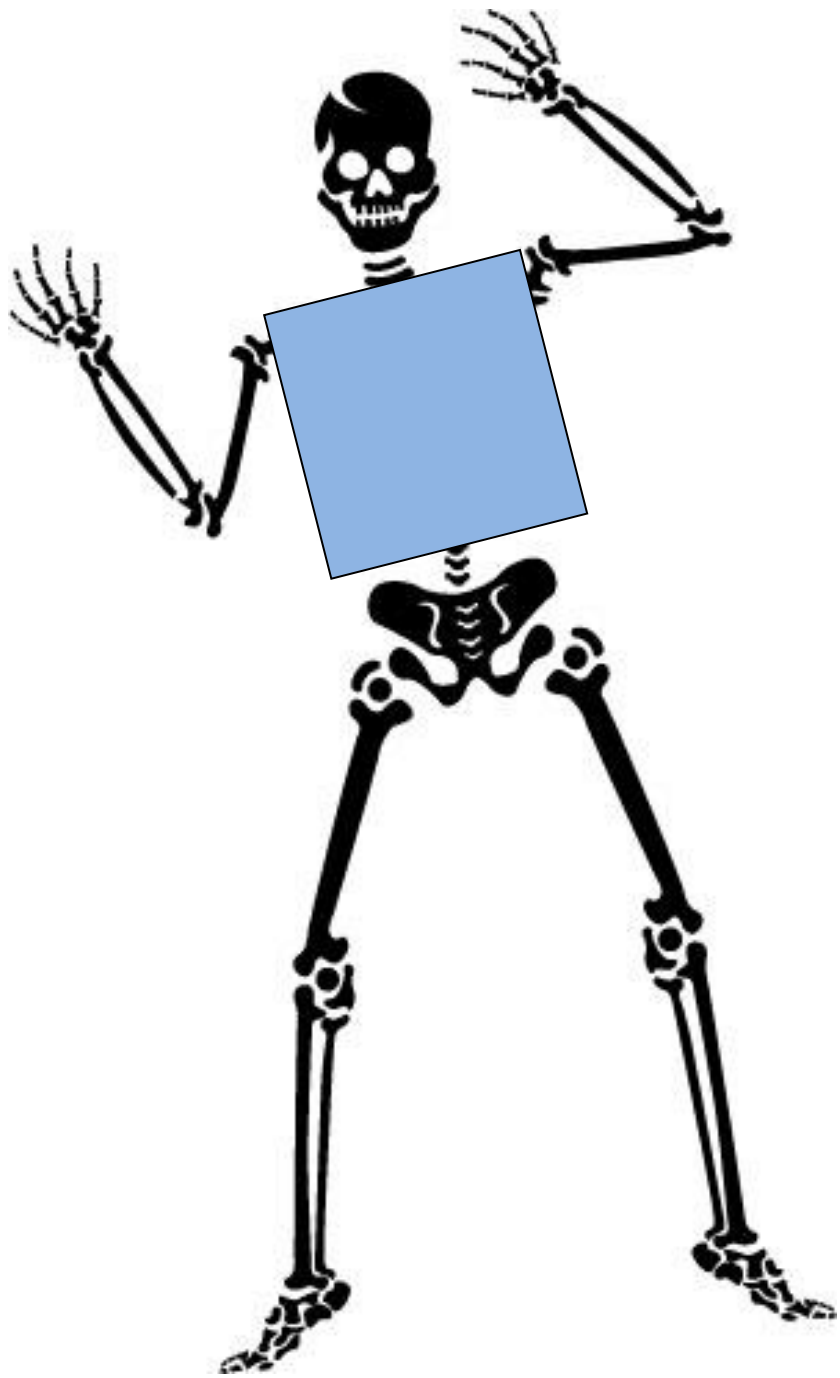

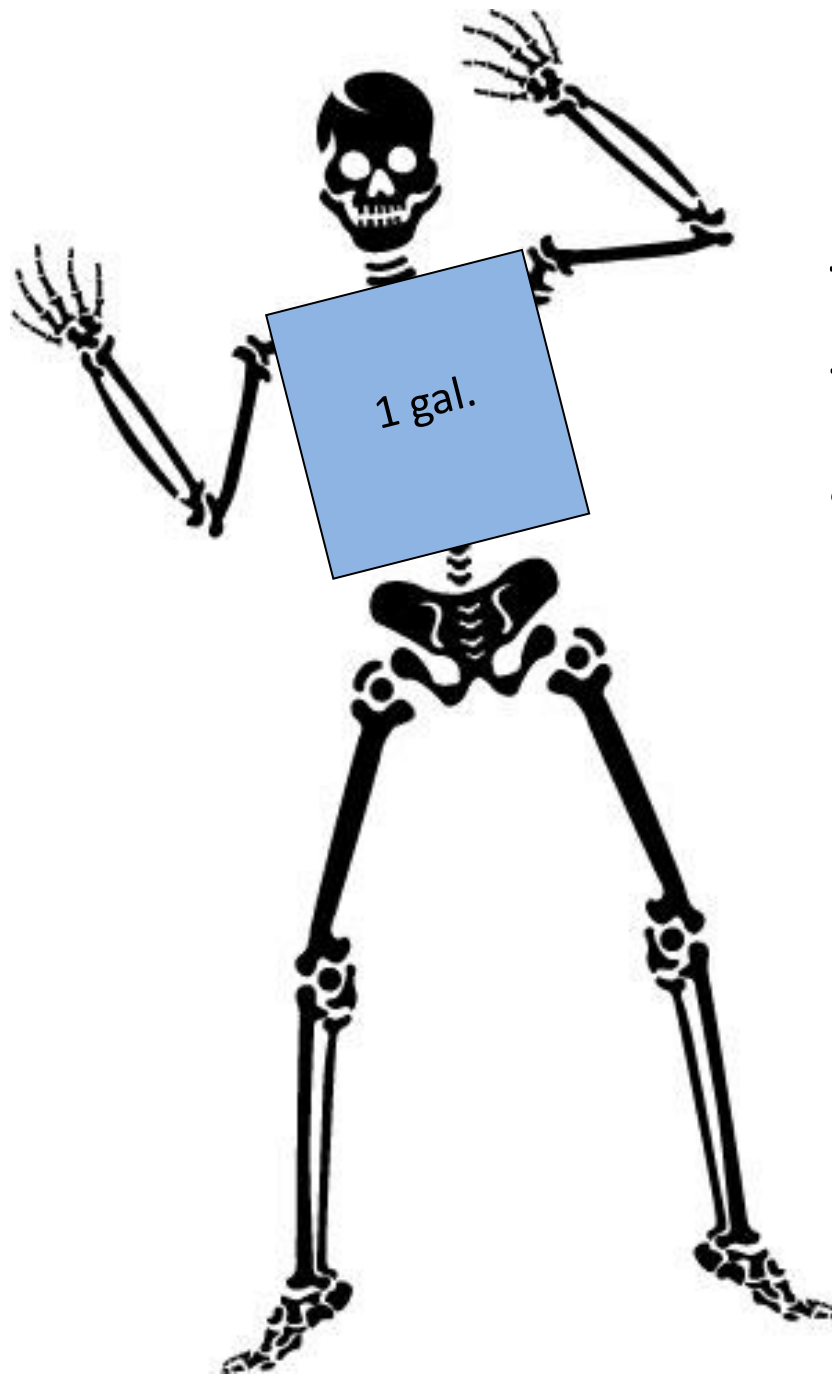
How to Remember Your
Gallon Equivalents!



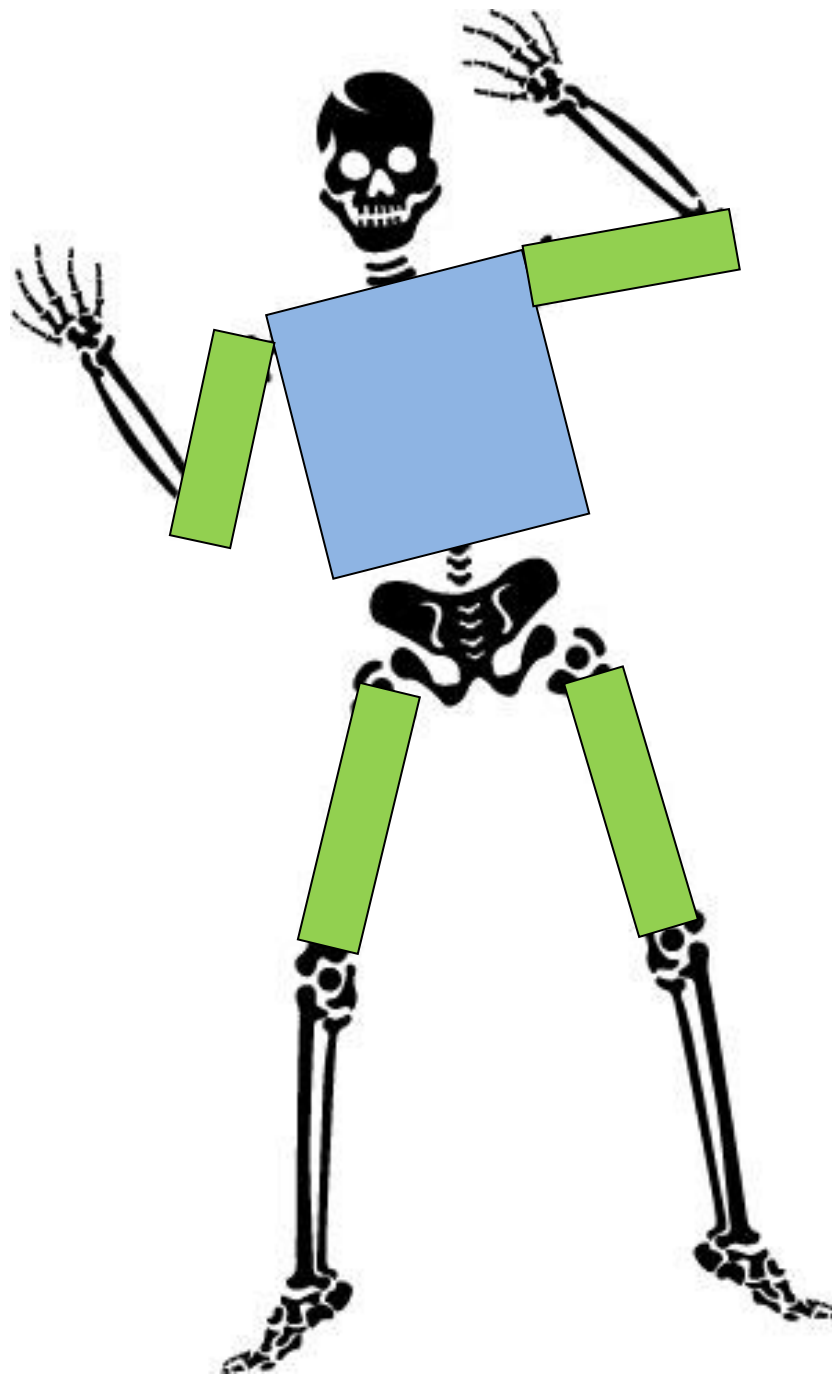
This is the

Say hello!

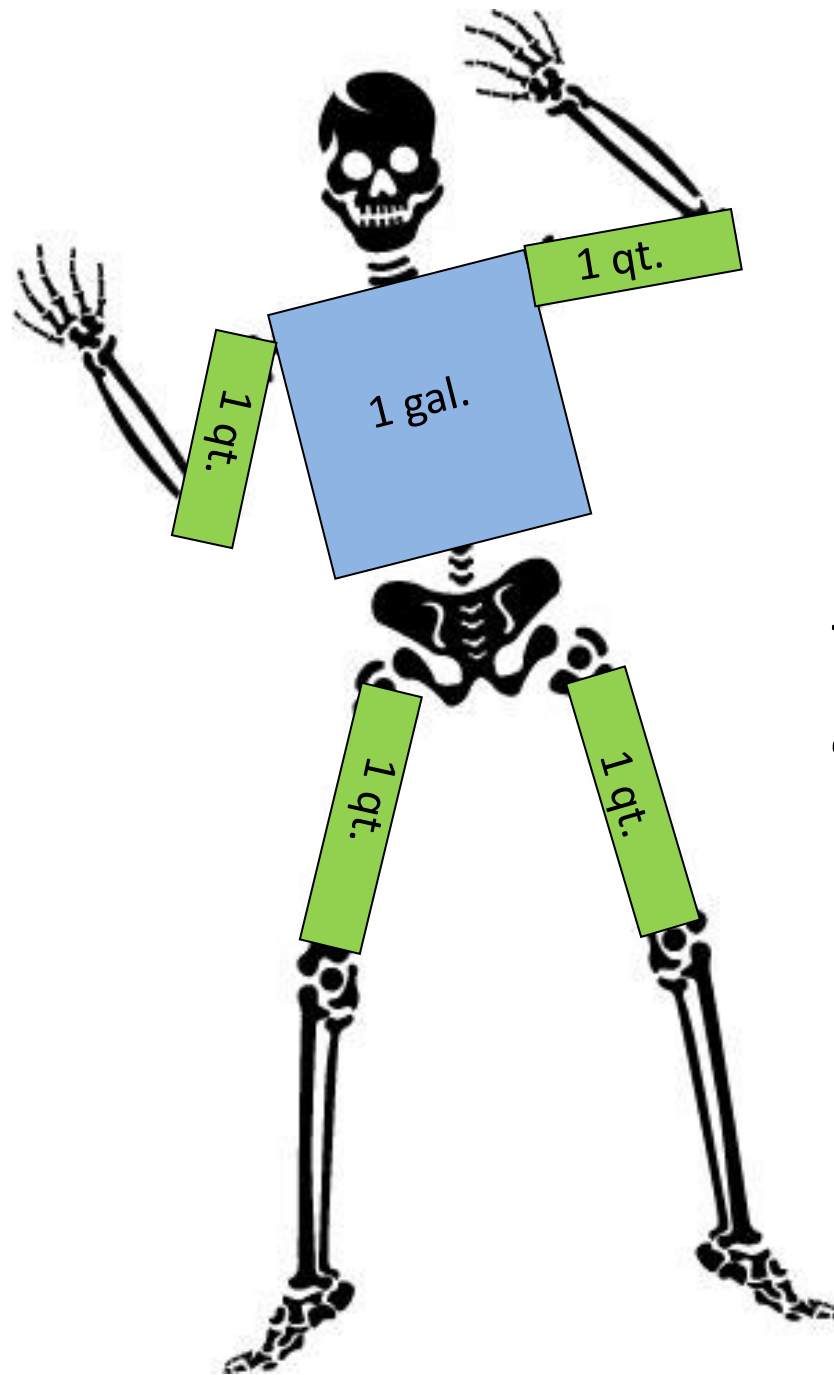




The core of

gallon (gal).



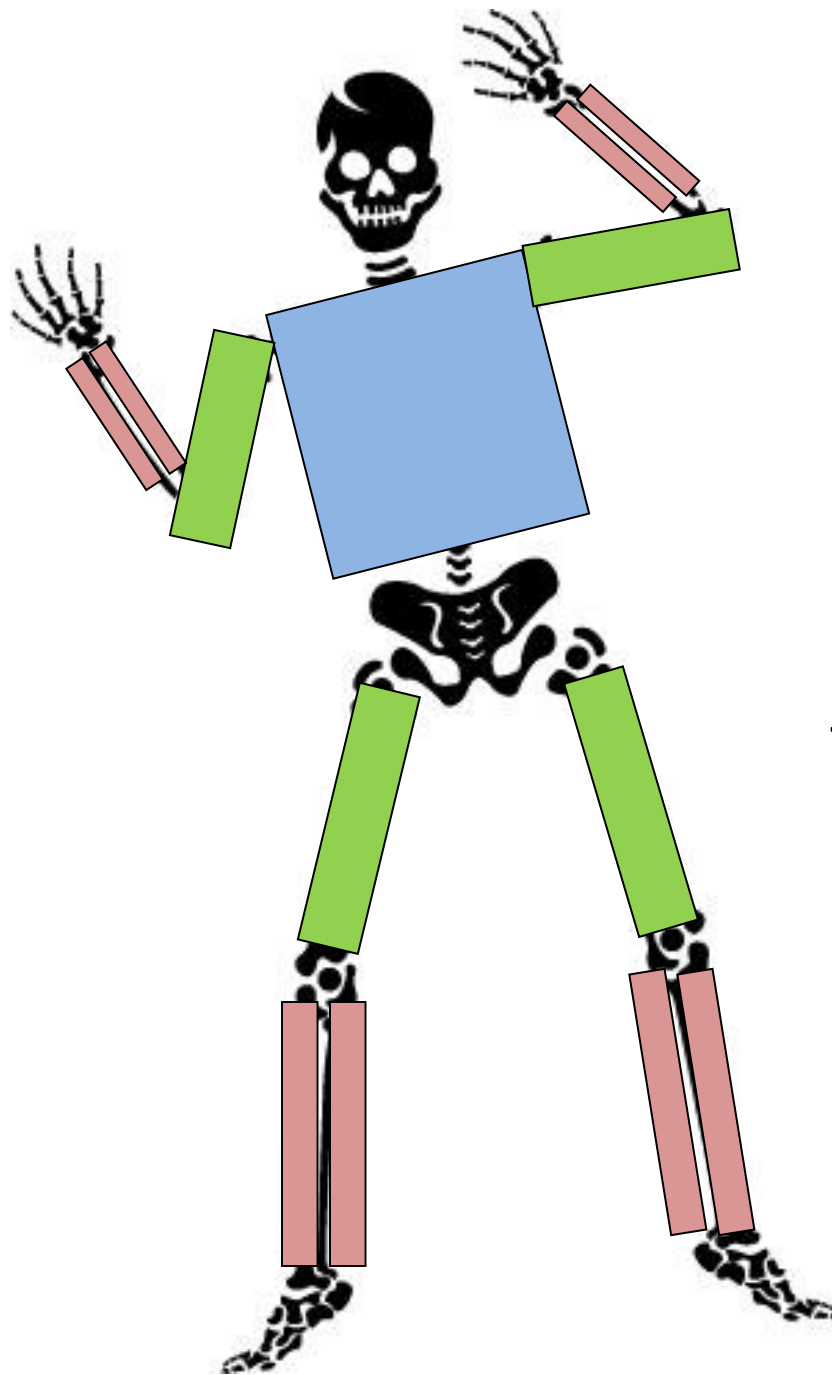
He has **arms**

me!



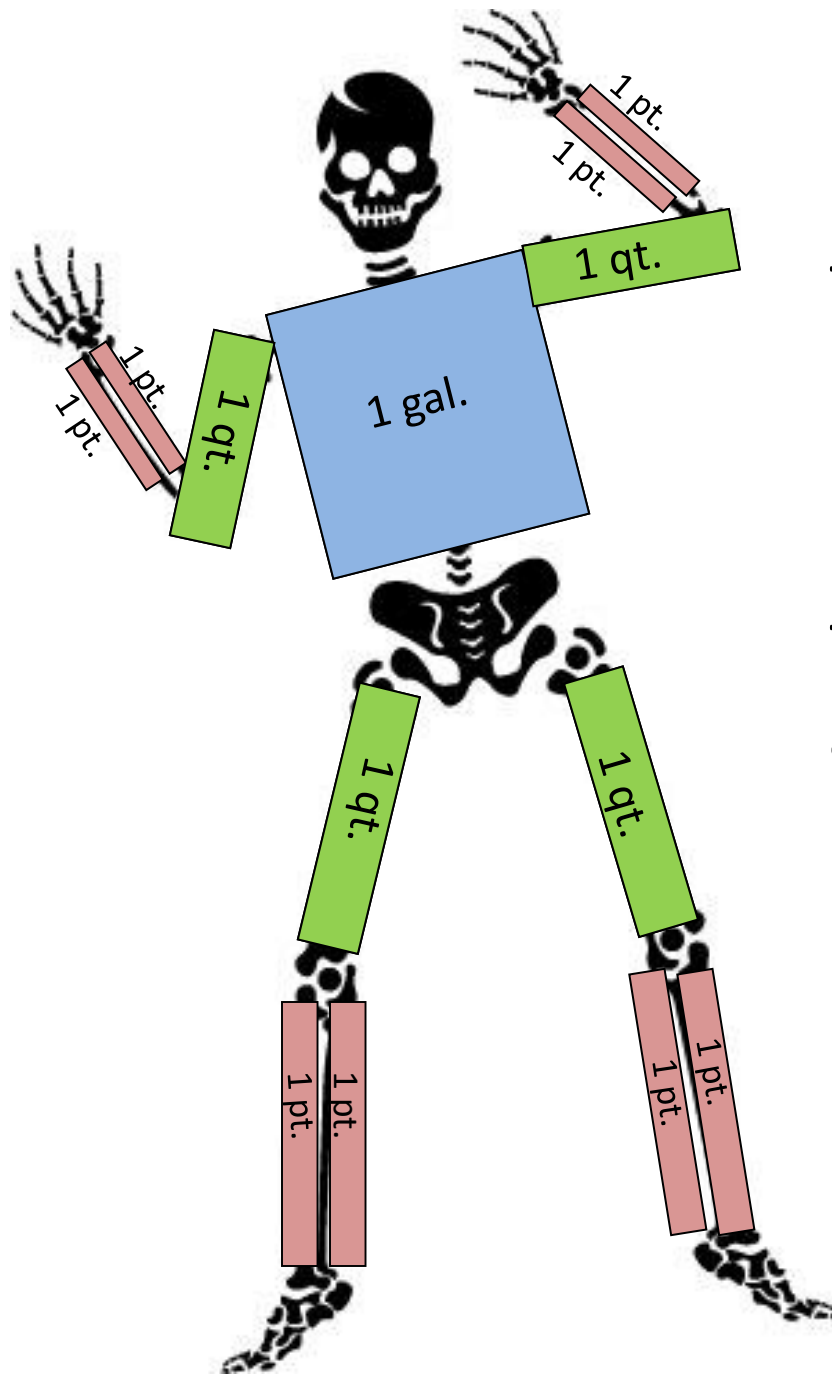
Each arm and leg represent a **quart**.

There are **4 quarts** in **1 gallon**.

... just like there are **4 quarters** in **1 dollar**!

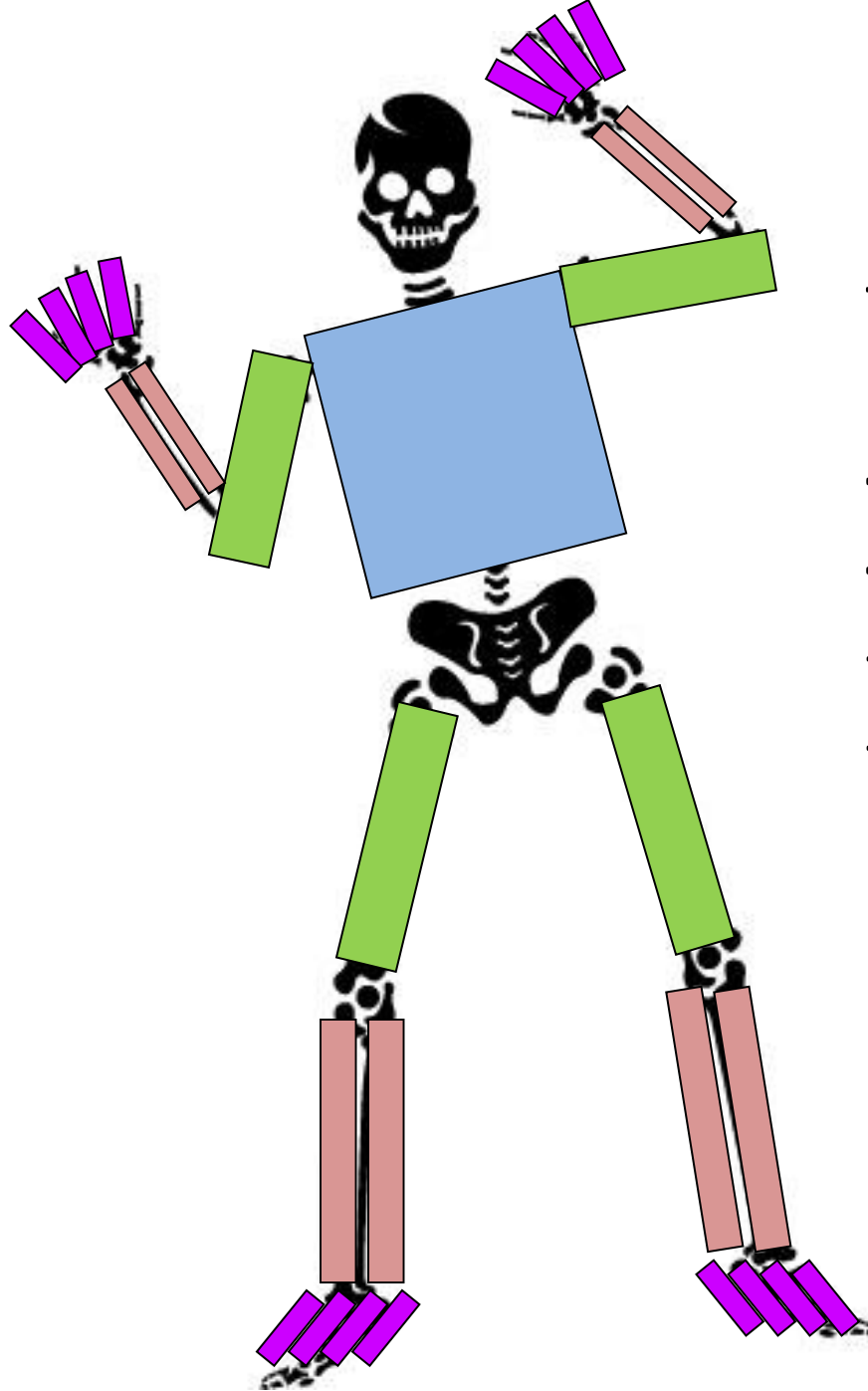


His **forearms**

there!

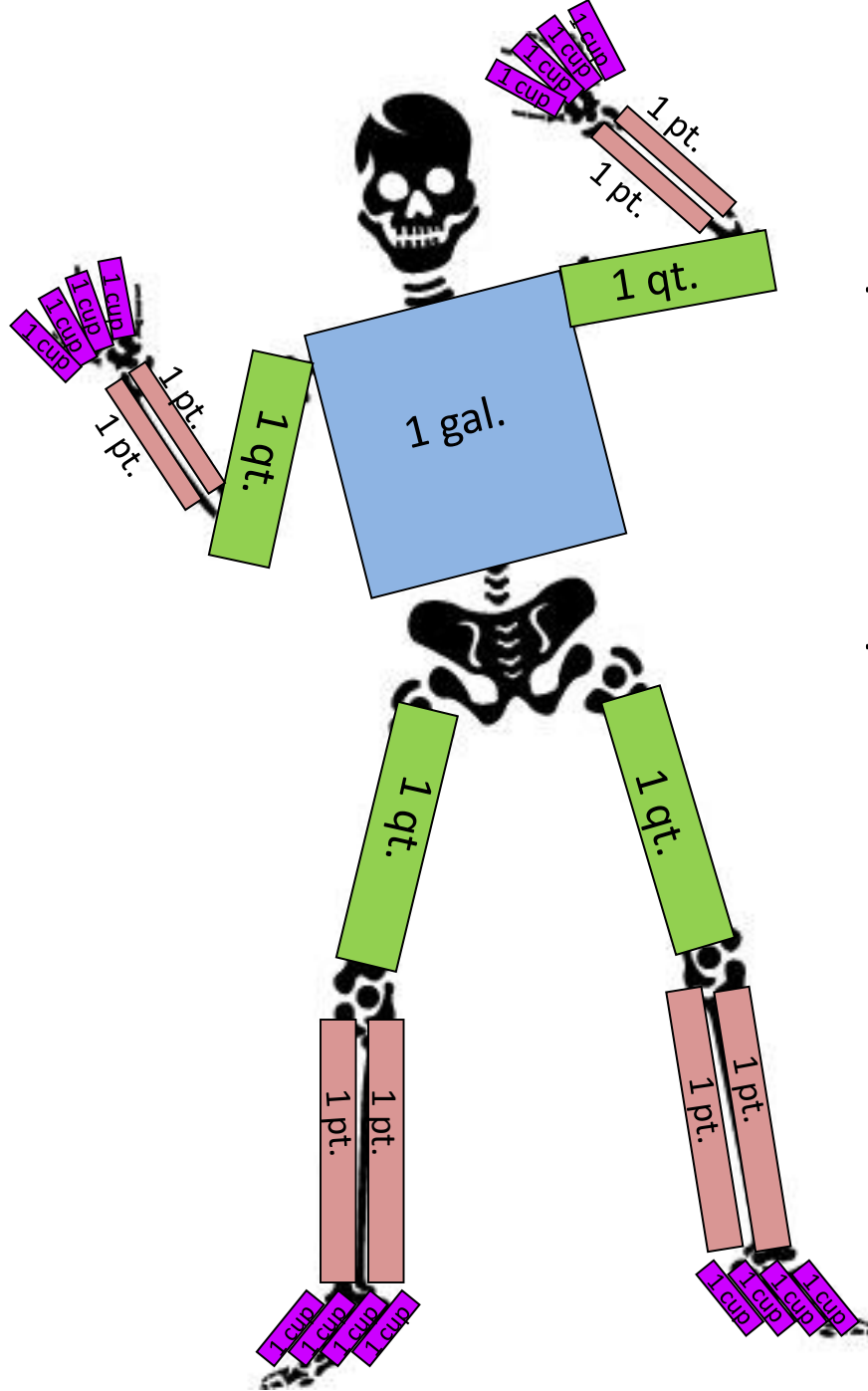


There are

1 gallon.



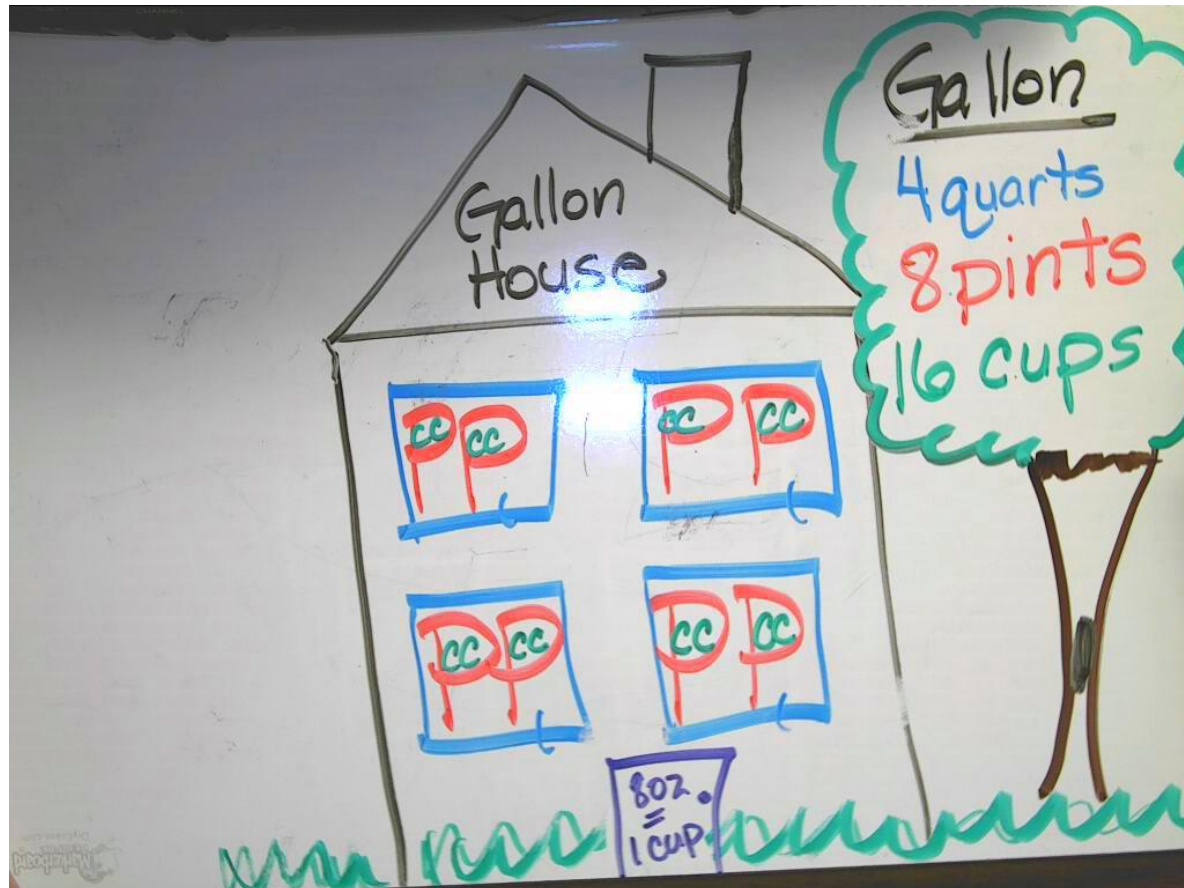
The Gallon

1 pint.

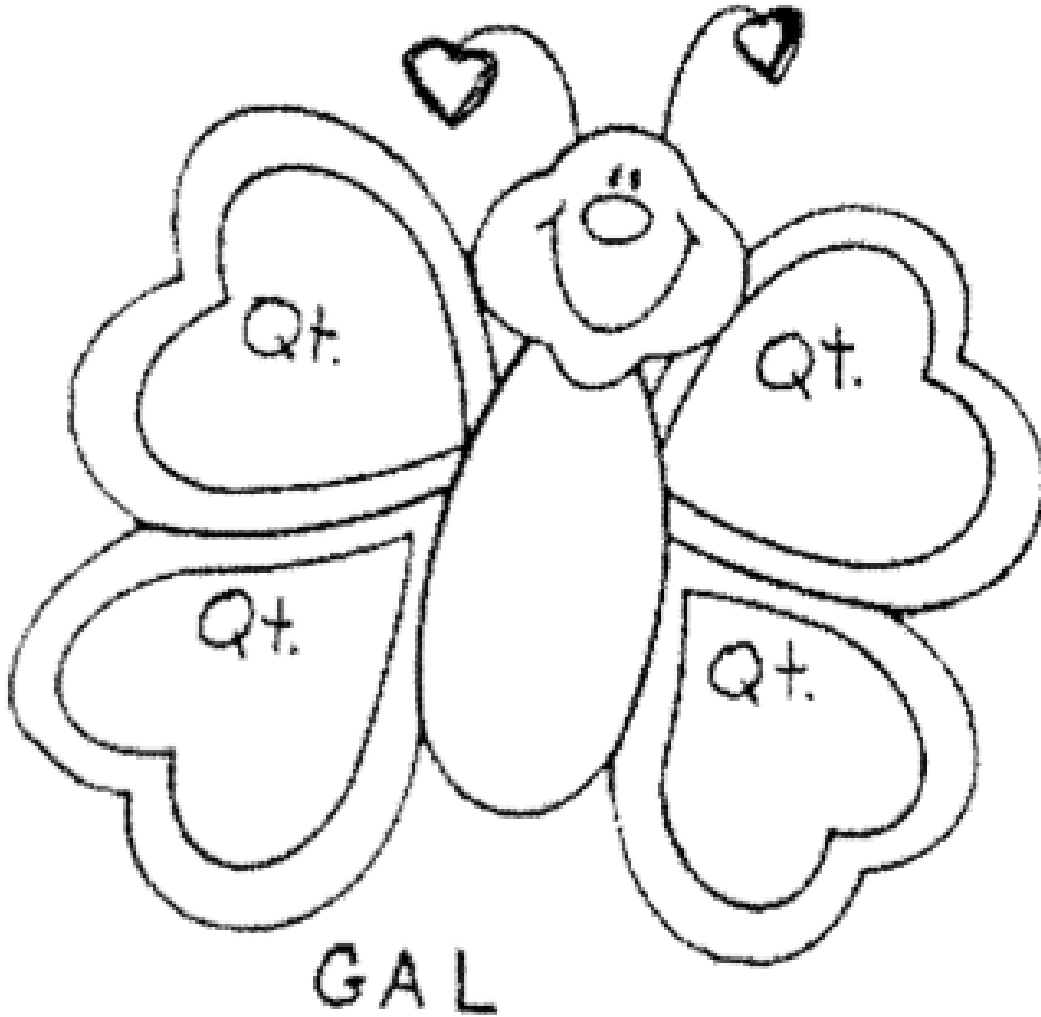
There are

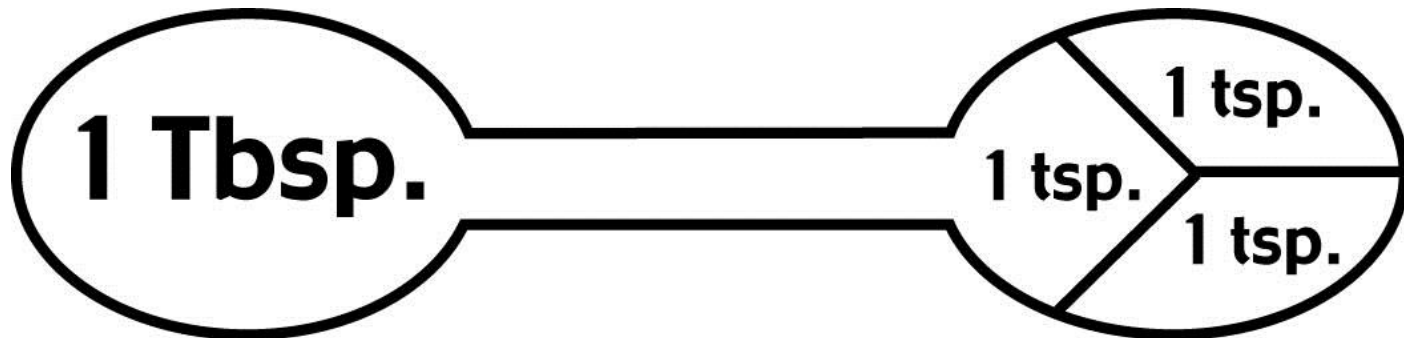
Meet Butterfly Gal

They are 3 little t's

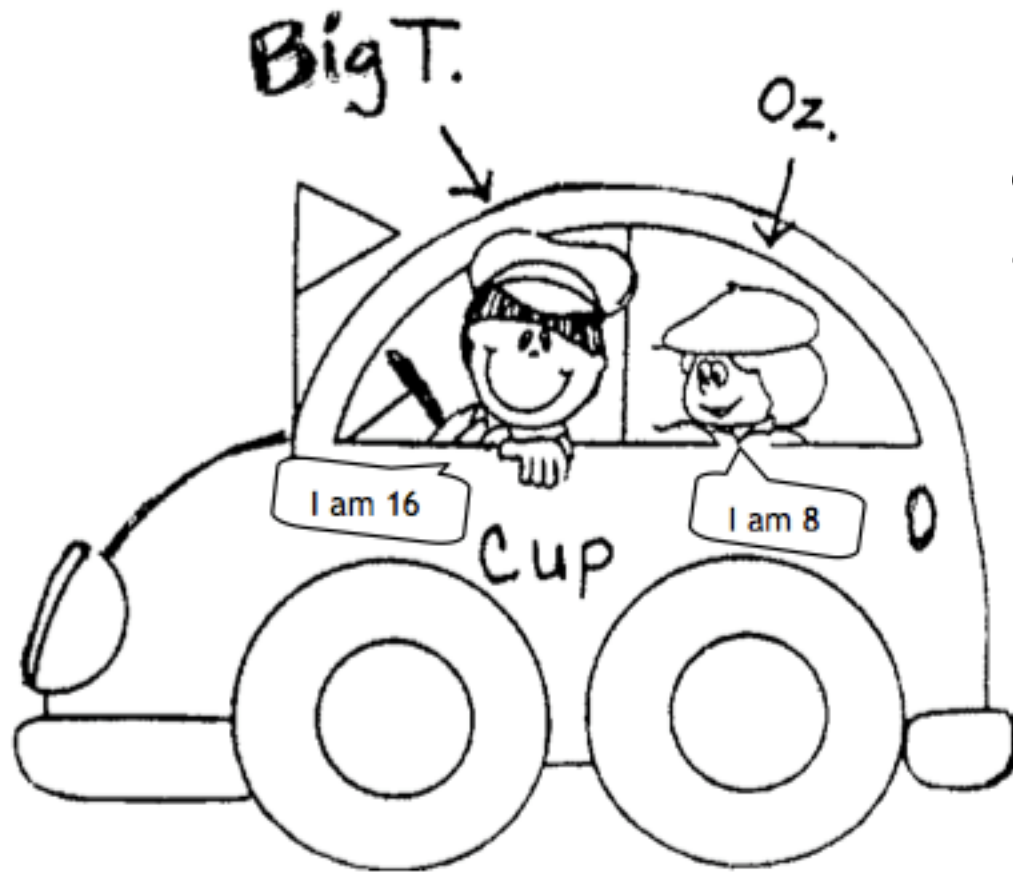
A Tablespoon has

Cup Equivalents!

1 cup = 8 oz.



1 cup = 16 Tablespoons



Big T turned 16 so he can drive the CUP car. His cousin Oz is 8 so he can't drive.

There are 16 T (tablespoons) in one cup.
There are 8 oz in one cup

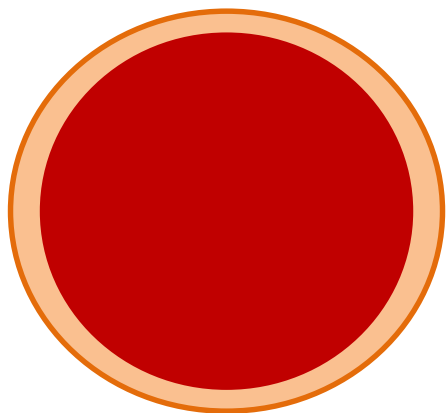
REMEMBER!



1 cube butter = $\frac{1}{2}$ cup

1 cube butter = 8 T

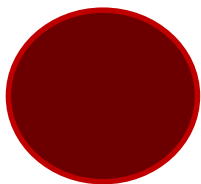

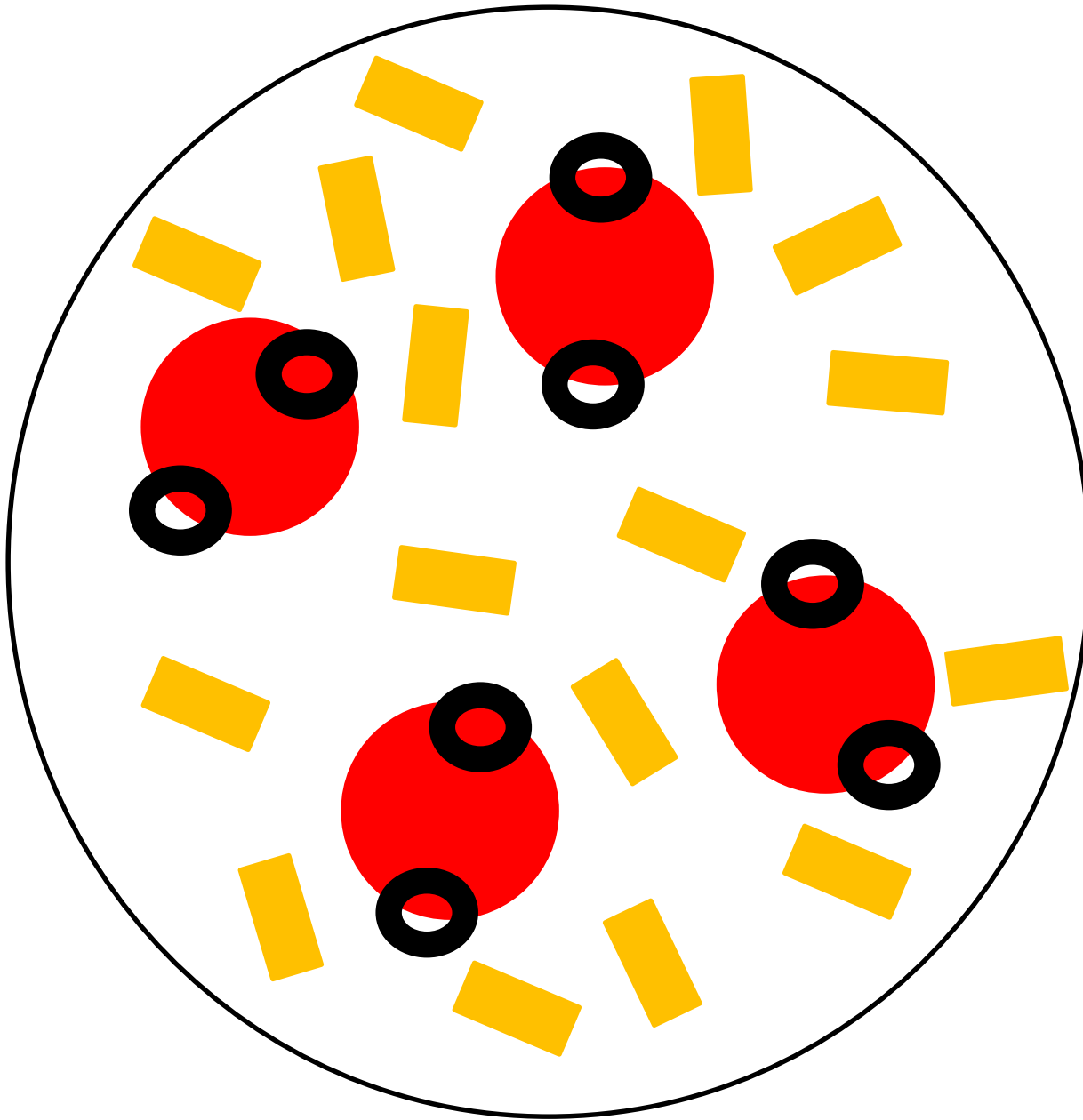

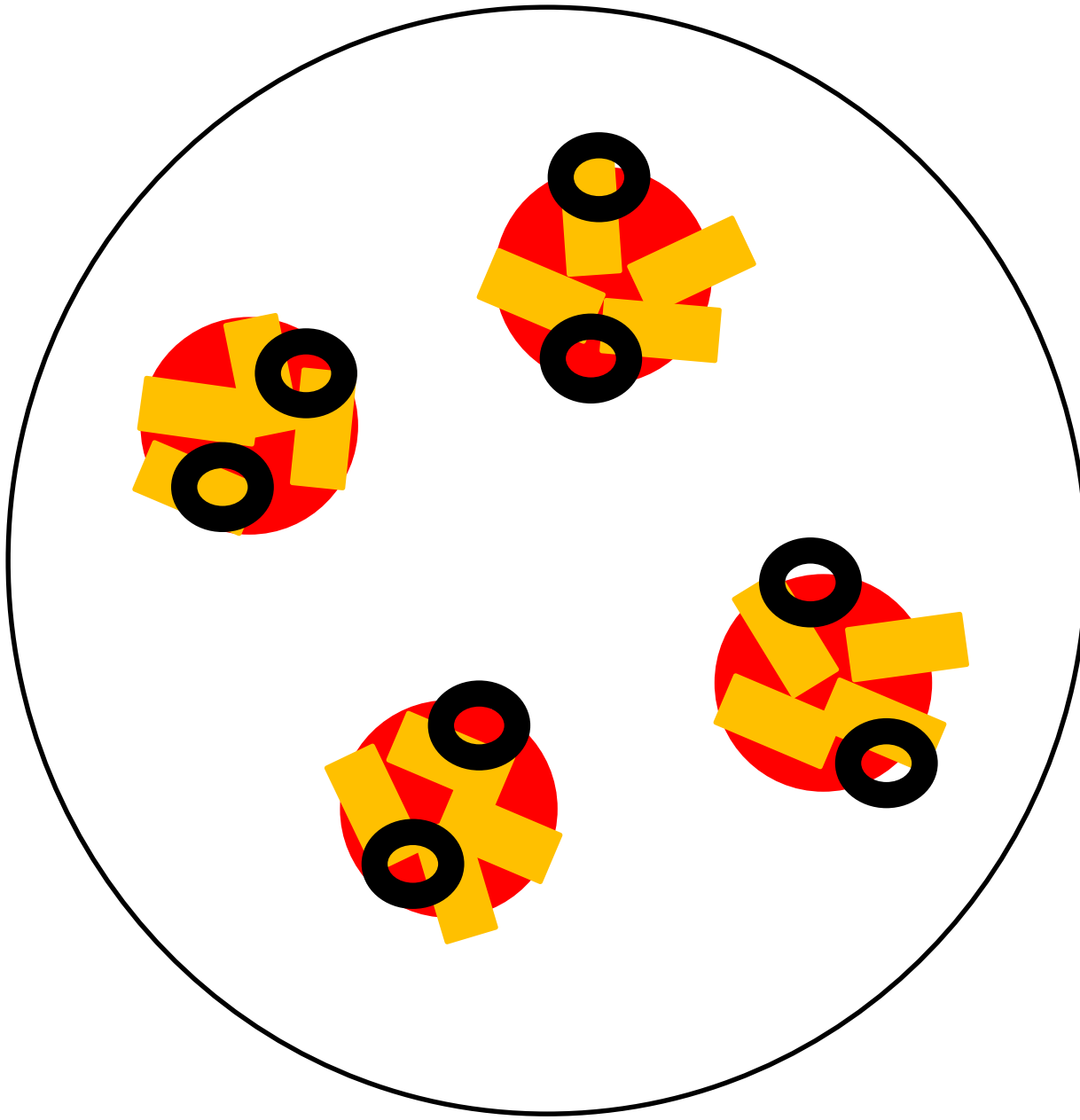
