- A birds eye view.

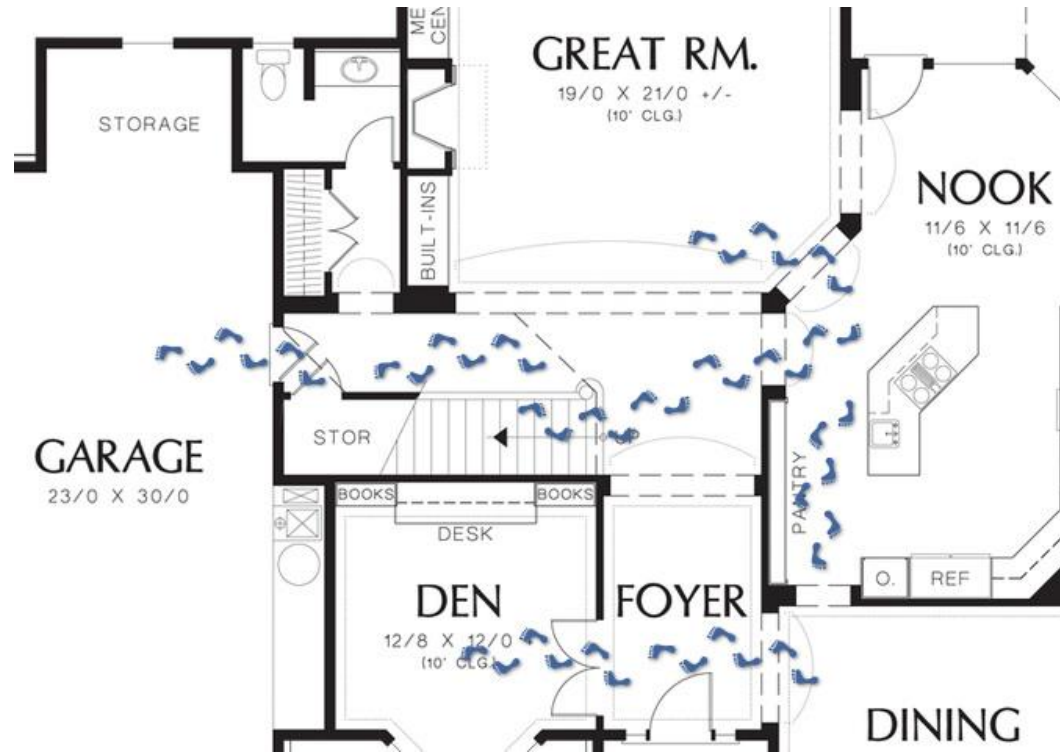

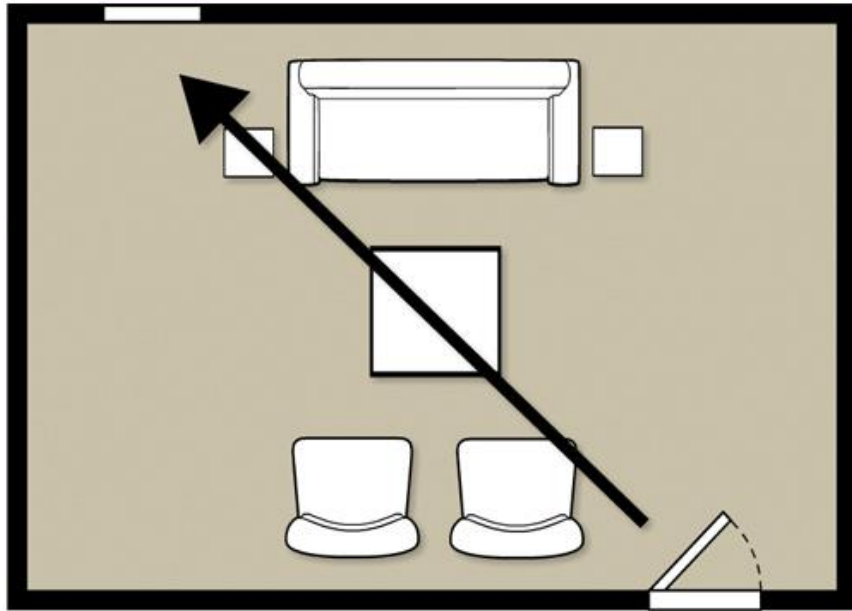
Traffic Pattern

- Considering how the room will be used and walked through by the people, when designing a room.

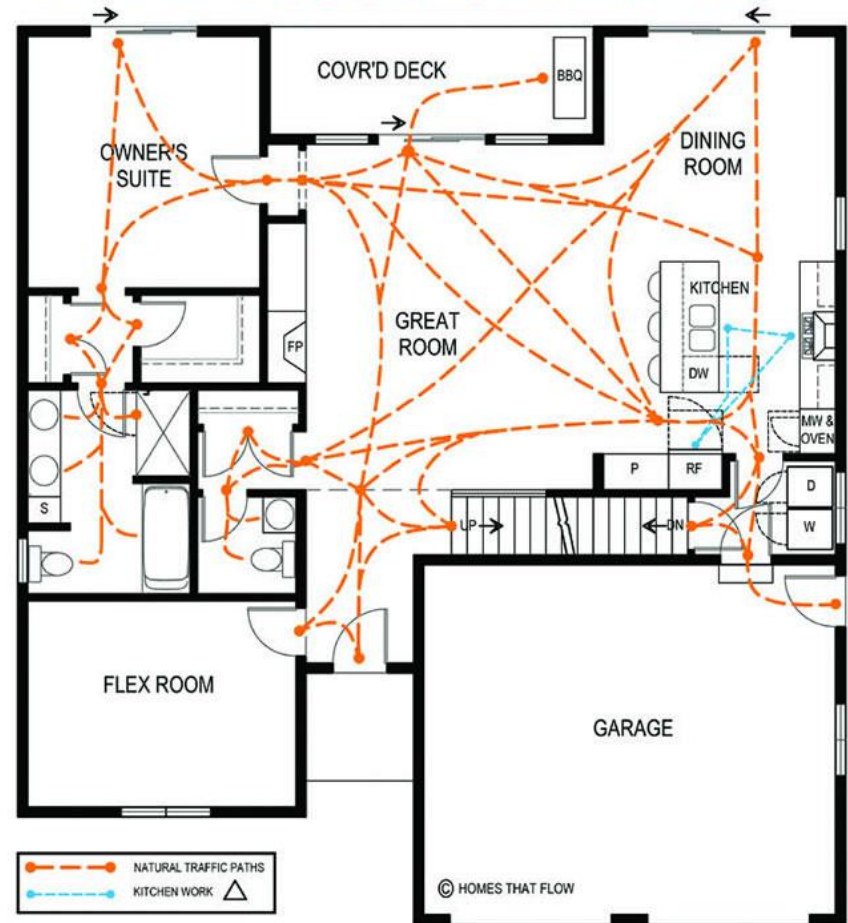


Are the people going to have enough space to get around comfortably?
